Y5/6 Countryside Day

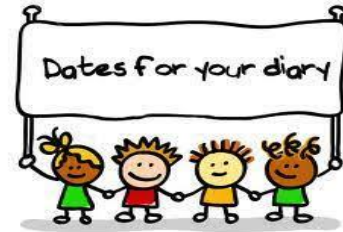
On Friday 7th July all the Year 5 and 6 pupils, who are in school and not at secondary transition days, will be going to Mossy Lea Farm in Glossop to take part in a special countryside event provided by Let's Learn Moor.

We will be leaving school at 8.30am and will walk to Mossy Lea. Children can arrive in school from 8.15am. They do not need to wear school uniform but must be appropriately dressed for a day of outdoor activities. Everyone must wear long trousers and have sturdy shoes such as trainers or walking boots. A waterproof coat is essential because we will be outdoors all day even if it is raining. The children also need a packed lunch and a water bottle.

The children will be accompanied by Mr Wilson, Mrs Elliott, Mrs C, Lydia Pickerhill and Mrs France.

The day is due to finish at 2.15pm and children need to be collected from the turning circle, Shepley Street, Old Glossop at 2.45pm. There is very limited parking at Mossy Lea Farm so PLEASE do not come there to collect, we will walk the children to the turning circle for collection. If someone else is collecting your child, please make sure you inform school.

There is a full day of activities planned including sessions with the rural crime team, the ranger service, moors for the future and dogs on the moor. It promises to be a lovely fun packed day which we will be sharing with other Glossop schools.
