SATS 2023 week will be Tuesday 9th May – Friday 12th May

Towards the end of Key Stage 2, Year 6 children take the KS2 SATs (Statutory Assessment Tests). The children are assessed during the middle of May 2023. Unlike Key Stage 1 tests which do not have strict time limits, the Key Stage 2 tests are strictly timed. The following chart gives the timetable for Key Stage 2 tests in 2023.
