Important Information

This term we will continue to have two PE sessions a week. These are going to be on a Wednesday and a Friday afternoon. If your child has trainers that require them tying laces, please help them learn at home as this can take up a lot of our PE time.

Homework

Every half term your child will come home with a homework sheet. On the sheet there will be three options based from what we will be covering throughout the year. We try and vary the different homework options so there will something that all pupils will enjoy. Please select one option and complete that homework by the deadline. Any questions regarding homework please come and ask. All children who complete their homework will get a punch on their punch cards.

Times tables Rockstars

Please keep encouraging your child to play on TT Rockstars. This is a fun way for children to learn their times tables. In year 2 our main focus is knowing the 2,5- and 10-times tables. To know the times tables well enough they need to be able to answer mixed up multiplication questions, division questions and missing number questions all based on the times tables. They should also be able to do this quickly. Every few weeks I will be testing the children on their times tables using the TT rockstars worksheets.

Over the next 6 weeks see if you can complete any of these challenges.

1. Make sure you are fluent with your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
2. Spend 3 minutes a day on TT rockstars.

Spellings

Every **Friday** your child will come home with 10 spellings. These spellings are chosen based on the spelling rules we have been practicing in class. They will be tested on these spellings the **following Friday**. They will come home with a word sheet as well as a practice sheet to practice on. Please encourage your child to practice their spellings as it will really help their reading and writing. We advise no more than 5/10 minutes practice a day. I understand that lots of our children do lots of other activities outside of school as well.

Reading

Please try and find time to read with your child. When you've read with them, please initial their reading record to show they have read at home. The children get rewarded for doing extra reading at home. Any extra reading will really benefit your child's reading, writing and spelling.
