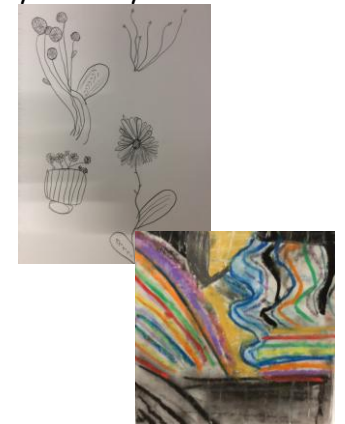
Children reading Little Wandle books need to bring in their book every day. It will be changed weekly. If they are a free reader when they have finished reading their book it is up to them to change it in the library.
