Project Homework

Class 3 are going to create an abstract sculpture based on play equipment. We will be using net shapes in Design Technology and using different ways of joining 3D and 2D shapes. This will be good practice for their sculpture. We will also practice different ways to make card shapes three dimensional, e.g. folding and curving the card or joining the flat shapes together. They will practise making slots, tabs, and using sticky paper towels to create a flange. The children will also plan their sculpture in school. A copy of their plan will go home and then they can get busy starting to create it. They will need to bring in their sculpture into school Friday the 15th of May.

Please keep an eye out for our Class trip to Chester on Parentpay. Children will need a lightweight waterproof coat for the walk and a small lunch box or bag.
