Project Homework

This term we are learning about different types of settlements. We will be looking at the village of Castleton, the town of Glossop and the city of Manchester. In the next week or so, please chat with your child about the settlement they want to research. We want them to write a tourist poster or booklet about their chosen settlement. They will need to research what things they can see or activities they can do. This needs to include places to eat and the use of any available transport links. The deadline is Friday the 10th July. I will send out an information sheet next Friday with more details about the project.

Times Tables Test

Times tables test will happen on a Friday too. The children can practise at school in the morning but they will need to practise at home too. We will start with our 2 times table, then 10 and 5 times table. We will move onto the different times table only when a child is ready, working towards decimals. They need to know the multiplication fact e.g $4 \times 10 = 40$ not just counting in 10s.
