Moor Knowledge for Class 4 and 5

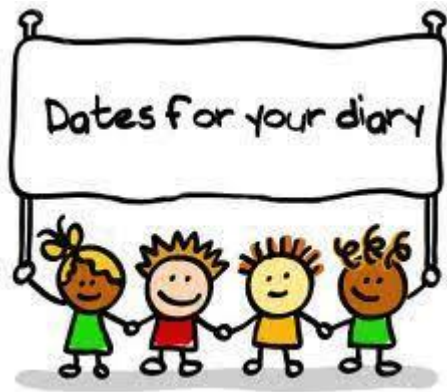
