Non Uniform Day

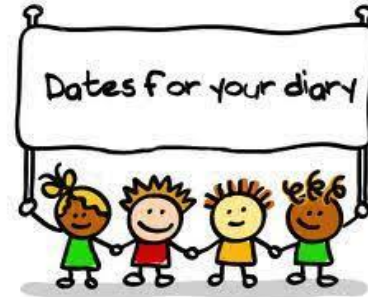
